Car Cane

At the November Flower Pot meeting, Thelma Farrell told members about a device she had recently purchased that she thought others may also find useful. The tool is called the Car Cane. The cane securely hooks directly into the door latch of your car allowing you to get a steady grip when you need it, so helping you to get in or out of the car.



The Car Cane is lightweight, durable and can withstand weight of up to 350 lbs. There is an LED flashlight and the grip can double up as a tool with a seat belt cutter and hammer to break glass in case of emergencies. It is widely available from companies such as Argos and Amazon at £14.99.
